Employment-related child protection

The ACT has introduced a reportable conduct scheme to oversee how organisations prevent and respond to employment-related child protection allegations.

The scheme commenced on 1 July 2017.

is covered by the scheme and will need to notify the ACT Ombudsman about allegations of reportable conduct involving an employee, which may include certain volunteers and contractors. Broadly, reportable conduct is child abuse or misconduct with a person under 18 years old.
